

NEFF's mission-driven programs offer an opportunity to put our region's forests to work on perhaps their most important mission ever—maintaining a safe and healthful climate. NEFF's **"30 Percent Solution"** for climate change mitigation could keep more than 646 million metric tons of CO2 out of the atmosphere over the next 30 years. This represents nearly 30% of the energy-related emissions we need to eliminate over the next several decades in order to meet New England's decarbonization goals.

NEFF's three strategic initiatives impacting the **30 Percent Solution** are: forest conservation; Exemplary Forestry practices; and innovation in sustainable wood buildings.


